Dear Parents,

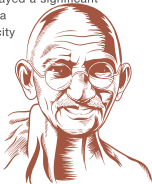

'I feel special today, it's my birthday'

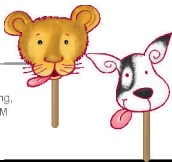

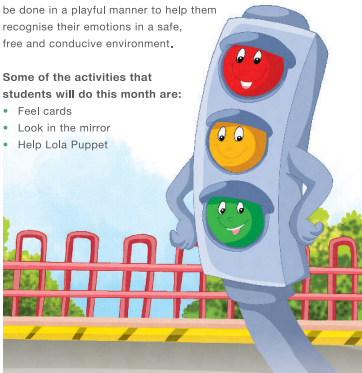
